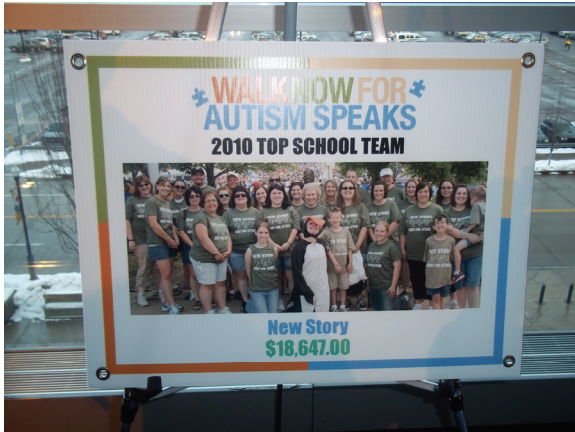


# New Story
