



AARON SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The Aaron School daily dress code is **smart casual**. Smart casual attire is comprised of well-fitting, neat, and situational- appropriate clothing, including slacks, jeans, sweaters, blazers, dress shirts, dresses, dresses, and skirts. Clothing should be well-fitted, not tight, and free of tears and fraying. Footwear should also be well fitted and be secured to the feet to ensure safety. Well maintained athletic or walking shoes, dress shoes, dress boots, and sandals with straps across the foot are consistent with a smart casual dress code. The dress code is subject to change at the discretion of the Head of School.

***Jeans should not be worn for parent and/or professional meetings/events (i.e., parent conferences, curriculum night, science fairs). Professional attire is required at these times.**

Clothing that is not considered appropriate for work includes sweatpants/shirts, exercise pants, overalls, leggings, beach attire, flip flops, t-shirts, and any spandex or other form-fitting pants or tops. Dresses and skirts that end halfway up the thigh, shorts, tank tops, crops and halter tops, spaghetti-straps, and clothing with large logos, slogans and images are also not appropriate for the workplace. Undergarments should not be visible.

*No dress code can cover all contingencies, so employees must exercise professional judgment in their choice of clothing to wear to work. If you experience uncertainty about acceptable, smart casual attire for work, please ask your supervisor.
